



RETOOLED COMMUNITY SUPPORT PROGRAM

## Background

President Rodrigo Roa Duterte signed on December 4, 2018 Executive Order No. 70 entitled Institutionalizing the Whole-of-Nation Approach in Attaining Inclusive and Sustainable Peace, Creating a National Task Force to End Local Communist Armed Conflict, and Directing the Adoption of a National Peace Framework. The PEACE envisioned in EO 70 does not only include military efforts, rather this is the effort of all government agencies including Local Government Units.

The Whole-of-Nation Approach is the tool or the means in achieving inclusive and sustainable peace. It simply says that all of Government's Agencies and all sectors of society must participate and tend their plans, objectives, programs and actions towards achieving this peace. This would also harmonize the delivery of basic services and social development packages.

One of the mandates of the Local Government Units is to deliver basic services and improved social development packages including peace and order. Having the inherent responsibility of looking after their communities under the LGC, the LGUs are now being called to lead this effort to win back communities to the government's side by promoting peace and development.

To ensure the localization of the EO 70 and the Whole-of-Nation Approach, the DILG together with other NGAs and LGUs implemented the Retooled Community Support Program (RCSP) as the solution to the persistent problem of insurgency in the Country. As an innovation to the RCSP, DILG Bicol implemented the *Baranggayansa*. This injects in the program the immersion in the priority barangays for the duration of the activity, through the conduct of activities on site and personally engaging the communities.

The response now is to develop these communities to end the problem on insurgency while promoting development and progress through improved basic services delivery and good governance.

## Roles of Key Persons

**LCE** - The local chief executives (LCEs) shall be the key person in the implementation and realization of the goals of baranggayan. The LGU core team shall be organized by the LCE and shall discharge their functions under his/her direction. The LCE shall also endorse to the LDC priority projects of barangays as identified



people. Community immersion of DILG officers is the key strategy in the success of baranggayan. For the whole 7-day-duration of the program, DILG officers stayed with the community and ensured that all required outputs are accomplished.

**DILG** - The DILG shall be the lead agency in the implementation of the program. DILG implementers composed of the Host C/MLGOO and the Baranggayan facilitators (also C/MLGOOs cross-posted or from the same province) shall immerse in the barangay to have a more personal relationship with the community and at the same time gain the trust of the

**NGAs** - Partner NGAs in the RCSP shall assist the lead agency based on their agency roles. They shall also provide solutions to the identified needs of the community by providing technical assistance and updating them of the PPAs to be implemented in their community or adopting PPAs identified as needs of the community.



## Goals/Objectives/Output

**BDP** – After the conduct of the activity, the final output shall be the enhanced barangay development plan. This shall translate the developmental plans of the barangay and shall serve as an opportunity for higher LGUs and NGAs to fund out such identified projects.

**BBI Strengthening** – As part of the program, BBI orientation shall reorganize and/or orient BBIs to improve the services in the community.

**Conduct of Serbisyo Caravan** – NGAs and the LGU offer and introduce their services and programs to the barangay. In a program conducted for the activity in the barangay, all participating NGAs and the LGU setup their booths for them to entertain people in the community.

**Conduct of solution-seeking dialogues**– LGUs and NGAs congregates with the Barangay and discuss among them the finalized EBDP concerning the identified issues by the barangay. Agencies responds to the said issues either by committing to fund out the needed PPAs or offering their existing program. Concerned LCE is also present to lobby projects to their council for inclusion in their LDIP.
